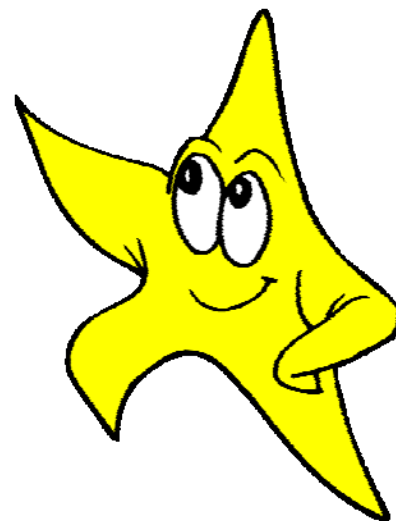

IN-STUDIO DRESS REHEARSAL:

The week of **May 7th – May 10th**, all students should wear their costumes to class in order to make sure that all performing details are taken care of prior to recital. Stage hair and make-up are optional. Please make sure all your costumes, shoes, and any accessories are labeled.

The dress rehearsal will be done at the beginning of class and **students should bring other class attire to change into afterwards.**



SHOES & TIGHTS:



Pink ballet shoes, *tan* tap shoes, *tan* jazz shoes and *white* cheer shoes are required. Only boys and competition team members are allowed to wear black shoes. **All other shoes for the recital must be pink, tan or white.** All students performing in the recital, except cheer and tumbling, are to wear tights purchased through the studio so we have a uniform appearance on stage. **Tights can be purchased at the front desk for \$11 plus tax.**



STAGING REHEARSAL:

Staging Rehearsal will be held at the Dallas Center Grimes High School Auditorium on **Friday, May 18th**. Please see the attached schedule (pg. 9) for your child's practice time.

Please wear your Purple Superstars T-shirt and black pants/shorts. Please note, this is not a "Dress Rehearsal"; students will not wear their costumes at the Staging Rehearsal.

Due to events from years past, we must emphasize that at rehearsal all children need to be supervised at all times and please **NO FOOD OR DRINK** in the auditorium. Thank you for your cooperation.

Friday, May 18th REHEARSAL DALLAS CENTER-GRIMES HS AUDITORIUM

The Superstars do not run a full costume dress rehearsal; therefore students do **NOT** need to wear costumes for this rehearsal. Students will wear their purple studio t-shirt and black pants or shorts. Participants should sit in the auditorium and wait until their class is called. Please NO FOOD OR DRINK in the auditorium as per the schools rules. When their class is called, students will report to the lobby outside the auditorium doors with the appropriate shoes and any props (baton, poms, etc...) in hand. Combination class students will need to bring **both** tap, jazz and/or ballet shoes backstage with them. Once the combo class has completed their first routine, students will change their shoes **backstage** for the second routine. Students in multiple classes and/or combination classes, please review the schedule carefully to determine which shoes your student will need first. Once the students are finished with all their routines, they can be picked in the lobby outside the auditorium and are free to go.

STUDENT NAMES: Students' names are listed in the program for each class and we need your help to verify the correct spelling for your student(s). Please check the list at the studio reception desk to verify your student(s) information and initial to confirm the accurate spelling for the program. Thank you for your assistance.

RECITAL ORDERS: The FINAL recital orders are posted around the studio we encourage parents and students in multiple classes to review and notify the staff of any back to back performances. We understand that some students will have quick changes and there is a room off the stage available for quick changes only, please see a Superstars staff member at rehearsal for directions to the quick change room.

REMINDERS FOR RECITAL DAY: Please arrive 30 prior to the recital start time; students in the first 15 acts should be dressed and ready to perform. Students will report to the cafeteria to check-in and will remain there until their performance time. No male adults or children will be allowed into the cafeteria area once the show starts as we will be having many students needing to change in this area. **Students can be picked up at the conclusion of the recital.** ALL Students under the age 8 must be picked up by an adult – No Exceptions. All students are invited to stay for the Final bow at the end of each recital, Superstars Staff members will assist with lining students up in the auditorium to participate in the bow.

We encourage audience members to stay and enjoy the entire show, we have so many talented students at Superstars and the kids performing in routine #25 worked just as hard as the second routine in the show. Superstars' recitals are a manageable timeframe and we look forward to entertaining you throughout the show! Recital is much more exciting for the performers when the seats are full and the audience is engaged and supportive; let's show all the performers appreciation for all their hard work!

If for some reason you do need to exit during the show, please be courteous and do so in between performances.

Auditorium doors will open 45 minutes prior to the recital start time. Saving seats prior to the doors opening is strictly prohibited! Any items placed on seats prior to the doors opening will be removed, additionally any persons in the auditorium prior to the doors opening will be asked to leave the auditorium prior to the show. Parents that are not class volunteers are not allowed backstage.

* Flash photography and videotaping are not allowed during recitals as it can be distracting to the performers.

Jazz shoes or hip-hop sneakers are to be worn, no outside street shoes are allowed on the studio floor.

Dancers need to attend the audition based on the team they are currently on or by the grade they will be entering in the fall of 2018. All dancers should be prepared for ballet, jazz and tap in their audition and should bring appropriate shoes. Dancers are required to wear solid colored leotard, tan tights, solid colored booty shorts and have their hair pulled back.

***Students interested in competition dance are required to take a technique & recreational dance class during the 2017-18' year.*

Competition Programs and Frequently Asked Questions: The Grimes Superstars Competition Dance programs provide students the opportunity to take their dance and performance skills to the next level through additional class training and competition experience. Students attend a regular class and competition class each week; dance competition team members are also required to attend a dance technique class weekly; production team will practice one Saturday or Sunday each month.

These programs are designed to challenge the students, provide a chance to compete, enhance skills, and strengthen basic techniques, all at a manageable time commitment per week. The directors of Grimes Superstars take great pride in being able to offer these higher level programs at a reasonable time commitment so that students may still participate in school, church, and other community programs. As directors, we want students to be able to be "kids" and afford them the opportunity to be active members of their schools and community. However with that said, being a part of the competition team is a commitment that should be thoroughly considered as practices and performances are mandatory.

In addition to the Grimes Superstars Dance and Production Competition teams, this year we are once again offering a Pre-Competition combination class for 1st graders and up interested in competition dance. This Pre-Competition dance class will compete at a minimum of 3 competitions in April/May.

There is a lot to consider when joining a competition team, therefore we've provided a general **Frequently Asked Questions** for our competition team programs.

What Classes Are Required?

<u>Dance Competition</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Competition Team Classes are held on Tuesday evenings with Miss Lorainna, the class is 75 minutes long. • Team Members are required to take a regular 55 minute Combination Class in addition to their competition classes. • Team Members are also required to take a 30 minute Dance Technique class. • Finally, team members (new or aspiring) are encouraged to register for the technique classes offered this summer.
<u>Dance Production</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Production Practices are held one Saturday or Sunday a month and offered at a discounted rate. • Team Members are required to take a regular Hip Hop Class; these classes are 30 minutes and offered on various nights at the studio. • Enrollment in a Combination dance class is strongly encouraged for Dance Production team members.
<u>Pre-Competition Team</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pre-Competition team members are required to take Pre-Comp. Tap & Jazz class with Miss Lorainna on Tuesday nights; this will also serve as their regular Combination Class.

How Many Competitions Do The Teams Compete At And Is There Travel Involved?

<u>Dance Competition</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Dance Competition Team competes at 5 competitions. • 3-4 of the competitions Superstars attend are in the local area. • 1-2 competitions may be held out of the local area where overnight travel may be required; previous travel destinations include Kansas City, Omaha, Cedar Rapids, Minneapolis, and Davenport.

What Is The Expectation Of My Student For The Competition Teams?

As with any other team sport, students are expected to attend classes and participate to the best of their ability. With competition classes attendance is critical to the success of the team; therefore each team has strict policies regarding attendance with frequent unexcused absences leading to dismissal of the team. Absences are excused for activities such as school events that are required for a grade, family event such as a wedding, contagious illness with a doctor's note, absences are not considered excused are non-contagious illness without a doctor's note, vacation planned after the competition dates are announced, sports/extra curricular functions, homework, or work schedule.

Additionally, all competition camps and competition events are Mandatory for team members. Grimes Superstars does not dictate the schedule of the actual dance competitions, therefore we ask team members to leave the entire competition weekend open as Superstars has no control over when the teams will compete during the weekend. The studio is typically notified by the competition 1-2 weeks before the event of the performance times for the teams. We communicate this you as quickly as we can once it is received.
